U11 Cobra Developmental Program

No matter the league, our philosophy will be to provide the same team level training to all players in our program.

District or Club Rec.

Players who register with our club will have the choice of playing on a team in the local Club Rec. League or on a team trying for the opportunity to play at the District level.

District 6 may require travel anywhere in Eastern Washington. Sunday play could be a possibility in this league.

The Club Rec. league will be a local league and will either be a Valley only league or a combined league with teams from Spokane.

District Teams

There is no guaranteed placement for any club in the District 6 league.

Depending on the number of teams wishing the opportunity to play at the district level, exactly which teams represent Spokane Valley may be determined in a local qualifying tournament.



How do you form your teams?

Unless otherwise requested, our philosophy is to keep players who played together at U10 together at U11.

Players that wish an opportunity to play on a District Level team should register by **May 18th** for the best chance of placement.

Players who register by **May 26th** will have the best chance of training and playing with their friends on a Club Rec. team.

Teams trying to qualify for the District 6 league will be formed first and may or may not include a tryout.

Tryouts

Whether we have tryouts and the number of teams that will be formed will depend on two factors:

1. How many players in our program indicated a desire to play at the District level.
2. The skill level of those players.

If tryouts are deemed necessary we will do our evaluations the first week of June.

Scholarships

Scholarships are available for players that qualify. Forms and information are available on our club website.

How do I join!

1. Sign up for the Spokane Valley FC using paper or online.

MAY 18th — Those players wishing an opportunity to play on a District level team should register by this date to have the best chance for placement.

MAY 26th — Priority Registration deadline for Club Rec. players.

2. If registering before May 18th, please email tom@spokanevalleyfc.org and indicate your preference of Club Rec. or District Play.
3. Check our website after May 18th for our early-bird training sessions.
