Cobras Competitive Program

Spokane Valley FC introduces the newest competitive soccer program in the Valley.



Our Cobras Competitive Program is designed to provide high level training to the players wishing to play in the Premier League.

Under the guidance of *Tony Dinaro, Cobras Program Director*, all Cobras teams will receive weekly scheduled training sessions during the season and have access to our weekly Goalkeeper training.

Spokane Valley FC Select Program

This is our traditional program designed to prepare teams to compete in the Select league run by District 6.

Every team in our Select program receives scheduled sessions with our club trainers and weekly Goalkeeper training.

We work closely with each team to tailor the training to the competitive desires of each team.

U11 Developmental Program

New this year is our U11 Developmental Program. Players in this program will receive regular scheduled training and Goal-keeper training and will play in a new metro league against teams throughout the Spokane area.

Some of our U11 Developmental teams may qualify to play in the new U11 league run by District 6 and compete with other teams throughout eastern Washington.
